1. Ammo Box Slide Fitment - Tools, Fasteners & Materials

The tables below show the equipment, I.e tools, fasteners, hardware and consumables required to complete the fitment of the Alu-Cab Ammo Box Slide.




Figure 1: Mounting Bracket Assembly






Figure 2: Frame Tray


1.1 Tools required to fit Ammo Box Slide kit:

Tool	Purpose
13mm Spanner	Fastening Nuts & Bolts
13mm Ratchet	Fastening Nuts & Bolts
Size 6 Allen Key	Fastening Bolts

2. Fitting the Ammo Box Slide Kit

Step 1: Fitting the Bottom Mounting Brackets

The first step to assembling you Ammo Box Slide is to attach the Bottom Mounting Brackets to your Mounting Bracket Assemblies. The M8 Button Head bolt and M8 Nyloc Nut fasten the Bottom Mounting Brackets to the Mounting Bracket Assembly. In Order from top to bottom, as shown in the below picture, first is the M8 Button Head bolt, then an M8 Washer, Mounting Bracket Assembly, M8 Washer again, Nyloc Nut and finally the Nylon Nut Cap. Repeat for all 4 corners. Figure 2 is of the complete assembly. Note: Only finger tighten until it is positioned in your Canopy to ensure ease of installation, a Size 6 Allen Key and 13mm Ratchet will be used to fasten it securely once positioned.






Figure 3: Fastener Order Bracket

Step 2: Fitting the Hex Nuts to the Frame Tray

The next step is to install the M8 Hex Nuts into the Nut Slots on the Ammo Box Frame Tray. There are 8 nuts in total which you simply push into the either end of the Nut Slots, 4 on either side of the Frame Tray. Next you can roughly align the Hex Nut positions with those of you Mounting Assembly slides for the next steps.

Step 3: Attaching Mounting Assembly to the Frame Tray

In this step you secure your Mounting Assemblies to the Frame Tray to make up your Ammo Box Slide. Here you will slide the Mounting Assembly Slides around the Nut Slots on the Frame Tray, then get a rough width estimation that will fit inside your Canopy. You can proceed to manoeuvre the Hex Nuts to align with the holes in the Mounting Assembly slides. Space the Hex nuts as far as possible apart, to their corresponding holes, to ensure maximum load distribution between the mounting points. You can then insert the 20mm M8 Hex Bolts with a Spring Washer attached into their holes, just finger tightening them to secure the Mounting Assemblies while allowing for adjustment while fitting it to the Canopy. There are 8 20mm Hex Bolts corresponding to each of their Hex Nuts in the Frame Tray.

Step 4: Mounting Points in Canopy

Now the mounting hardware needs to be fitted inside the Canopy to attach the Ammo Box Slide. There are 8 M8 20mm Hex bolts that need to be inserted into the Nut Slots in the Canopy, 4 on either side, to mount the Bottom Mounting Brackets to, you can space these to corespondent to the holes in the Bottom Mounting Brackets.

Step 5: Ammo Box Slide Mounting to Canopy

The final step in assembling your Ammo Box Slide Kit is to mount the product to your Canopy. Take the Ammo Box Slide Assembly into the Canopy and align the bolts with the holes in the Bottom Mounting Bracket, and fasten the brackets to the bolts in the Nut Slots using a washer and Nylock Nut. Once one side is fastened finger tight, move to the other opposite side and do the same. When both sides as secure you can now slide the Frame Tray within the Mounting Assemblies to position the tray where you like within your Canopy. When you are happy with the position you can finally fully tighten all the finger tight bolts to properly secure your Ammo Box Slide. Cover all Hex Bolts with Nylon Nut Caps.




Figure 11: Ammo Box Slide Mounted to Nut Slot in Canopy
